COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Introduction to Incident Command System, ICS-100

This course introduces the Incident Command System (ICS), a component of SEMS, and provides the foundation for higher level ICS training. This course describes the history, features and principles, and organizational structure of the Incident Command System. It also explains the relationship between ICS and the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

Incident Command System for Single Resource Incidents, ICS-200

This course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS).

Introduction to National Incident Management System, NIMS-700

This course introduces a nationwide template to enable all government, private-sector, and nongovernmental organizations to work together during domestic incidents.

Introduction to the National Response Plan, NIMS-800

This course describes how the Federal Government will work in concert with State and local governments and the private sector to respond to disasters.

Prerequisites: ICS-100, ICS-200, NIMS-700
