The meeting was called to order at 2:10 p.m.

Fee Request: Emerald Isle Housing Fees

Ms. Pat Francisco presented the agenda item. Ms. Francisco referred to the 2007/2008 Emerald Isle Housing Fees schedule and noted a correction regarding late payments, which are subject to a late charge of five percent (not three percent). The current rates are also included in this schedule and will be added to the information packet at the end of the year. The office of Housing Administration is now officially managing Emerald Isle. There is no longer a pool in this complex, since people were not using it; a barbeque area is being created. Emerald Isle is mainly composed of studios. There are some vacancies and they are currently trying to get graduate student residents.

Mr. Boyd asked about residential life program in the area. There is no residential life program per Ms. Francisco; she added that this complex is very similar to Piedra del Sol.

Mr. Rainer noted that the College of Extended Studies (CES) Fee Request has been pulled from today's agenda and will be presented at the next meeting.

Dr. Ely asked if the information item could be moved to action item at the next meeting. Mr. Rainer responded that it was possible as long as the committee agreed.

Dr. Ornatowski asked about current rent rates and how they compare to the rest in the area. Ms. Francisco responded that the rent for these is still under median rate. Dr. Ely noted that a studio at Piedra del Sol is \$847.00
