

SDSU Fall 2018 Fee Payment - (as of 02/26/2018)

The following fees are applicable for the Fall 2018 semester only. The CSU makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in published schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. Therefore, CSU must reserve the right, even after initial fee payments are made, to increase or modify any listed fees, without notice, until the date when instruction for a particular semester or quarter has begun. All CSU listed fees should be regarded as **estimates** that are subject to change upon approval by the Board of Trustees. Changes in mandatory system wide fees will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Working Families Student Fee Transparency and Accountability Act (Sections 66028 – 66028.6 of the Education Code). For the most current fee amounts, check online at www.sdsu.edu/sas. Students will be liable for amounts as a result of such changes.

Non-Resident Tuition (Out of State and Foreign)

In addition to Basic Tuition and Fees, a per unit fee is charged for all units attempted at a rate of:

- \$396 per unit (**Due in full by August 24, 2018**) or sign up on the Non-Resident Tuition Installment Plan (see below).

Professional Program Fee

In addition to Basic Tuition and Fees and Non-Resident Tuition, Graduate students in the College of Business must pay the following fee for all units taken as a requirement for graduation:

- \$270 per unit (**Due in full by August 24, 2018**)

Student Involvement Representative Fee (SIRF)

The CSU Board of Trustees adopted the SIRF, establishing a stable model for the California State Student Association (CSSA). The new funding model expands independence and builds capacity to engage students in advocacy and policy making. The funding model consist of a \$2.00 per-term fee assessed to each CSU student, on a voluntary basis, allowing the choice to opt-out each semester.

Basic Tuition & Fee/Non-Resident Tuition Installment Plan

The Basic Tuition & Fee Installment Plan can only be submitted **On-Line**. An initial payment of \$800.00 must be submitted in addition to the \$60.00 Installment Plan Service Charge. (For a total of \$860.00) The remaining balance will be split into four equal payments due August 20, September 20th, October 20th and November 20, 2018.

The Non-Resident Tuition Installment Plan requires an initial payment of 6.0 units totaling \$2376.00 (min. 6 units x \$396 per unit). The remaining balance will be split into 3 equal installments including a service charge equal to 5% of each installment payment due, totaling up to 15%. Each installment will be due on October 20th, November 20th, and December 20, 2018.
