### Spring 2010 Mandatory Campus Fee Descriptions

State University Fee	Must be used for non-instructional purposes only. For example: counseling, testing, placement, financial aid administration, health services.	<a href="#">See Reg Fees</a>
Student Body Association Fee	Supports student body organizations. For example: student government, newspapers, athletics, cultural programs.	\$35.00 Main Campus  \$65.00 IVC*
Student Union Fee	Supports the financing, construction, and operation of Student Body Centers. For example: Aztec Center, Student Activity Center.	\$143.00 Main Campus  \$24.00 IVC*
Health Facility Fee	Supports the leasing and construction of Student Health Services.	\$25.00 Main Campus  \$3.00 IVC*
Health Services Fee	Supports Health Services and health promotion programs.	\$85.00 Main Campus  \$10.00 IVC*
Instructionally Related Activity Fee	Supports a variety of campus programs. For example: radio, TV, newspaper, magazines, concert and marching band, athletics, art exhibits.	\$175.00 Main Campus  \$15.00 IVC*
Library Service Fee	Supports increased services at the library.	\$20.00
