### POOL OF PART-TIME LECTURERS

Applications are being accepted for a reserve pool of part-time faculty to be called upon if the need arises. Openings commonly occur in such courses as Engineering Problem Analysis, Engineering Measurement Analysis, Surveying, Geology for Engineers, Soil Mechanics Laboratory, Solid Mechanics Laboratory, Construction Methods, Construction Engineering, and Control of Human Environment. The deadline for accepting applications for the Fall semester is August 1 and for the Spring semester is January 1. Minimum qualifications typically include a M.S. degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering or related fields and two years of relevant industrial experience. For each subject area, the department will rank the candidates based on professional competence, educational level and prior teaching effectiveness if any. Salary will be commensurate with credential and experience according to University policy. Submit letter of application, including a statement of which courses you are qualified to teach, a vita and three letters of recommendation to Professor Kenneth Walsh, Chair, Department of Civil, Construction and Environmental Engineering, San Diego State University, San Diego, CA 92182-1324. Presently employed part-time faculty who wish to be considered for subsequent appointments need to re-apply by the deadlines indicated above for each semester they wish to teach. These candidates need to submit only a letter of interest. In consultation with Department Chair, the Dean of the College of Engineering will appoint the successful candidates.
