COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

NIMS an Introduction, IS-700.a

This course introduces and overviews the National Incident Management System (NIMS). NIMS provides a consistent nationwide template to enable all government, private-sector, and nongovernmental organizations to work together during domestic incidents.

Required Audience: All SDSU EOC Response Team members

Prerequisites: None

Course Length: Approximately 3 hours

Introduction to Incident Command System, IS-100.HE

This course introduces the Incident Command System (ICS), a component of SEMS, and provides the foundation for higher level ICS training. This course describes the history, features and principles, and organizational structure of the Incident Command System. It also explains the relationship between ICS and the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

Required Audience: All SDSU EOC Response Team members

Prerequisites: IS-700.a

Course Length: Approximately 3 hours

NIMS Public Information Systems, IS-702.a

This course provides basic information and tools to effectively manage public information at an incident regardless of size and complexity of the situation or the number of entities involved in the response.

Required Audience: SDSU Public Information Officers (Marketing and Communications)

Prerequisites: None (IS-700.a recommended)

Course Length: Approximately 3 hours

Helpful Hints!

The lessons for each course are broken down into 25 to 50 minute sessions. Work at your own pace, but it's best to complete one lesson so you won't have to repeat.

There is no tracking of the lessons within each course; there is only tracking of the final test (this is where you'll record your information in order to receive your Certificate of Completion).
