### Project Description

The Parma Payne Goodall Alumni Center is named for three alumni whose combined gift provided major funding for the project. It is the focal point for alumni activities and benevolent recruitment. It houses the offices of the [Alumni Association](#) and the [Campanile Foundation](#). The design incorporates an 8,000 square feet ballroom and full-service kitchen, SDSU Alumni Association offices, alumni board room, University Advancement staff offices, and other meeting and conference facilities and an abundance of outdoor terraces, patios and entertainment facilities. The open air rotunda facing 55th Street is a perfect venue for pregame gatherings and casual meetings. The site is easily accessible to Athletics, Viejas Arena and Parking Structure 5 to accommodate outside visitors.

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
