Project Description

The Donald P. Shiley BioScience Center, a 37,000 square feet facility, houses four floors of research laboratories and a 100-seat auditorium. Adjoining the existing North Life Science building, the center is the home of the SDSU Heart Institute, the Center for Microbial Sciences and other core programs. Research facilities include:

- Basement; animal lab facilities
- First floor; office space and a 100-seat, seminar room
- Upper levels; open architecture, wet lab space

Pass-through hallways connect it to the existing Life Science building at the basement and 4th-floor levels. The initial project scope completed the basement, first and fourth floors.
