- 1. CALL TO ORDER: Katie Olivo, CFAC Chair, called the meeting to order at 11:02am
- 2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA and PREVIOUS MINUTES:
 - a. It was motioned and seconded to approve the CFAC minutes for March 21st, 2025

3. PROPOSALS:

- a. Graduate Student Health Insurance Program (GSHIP)
 - i. Program provides health insurances to students without it, students with alternate insurance coverage may opt out. Proposed amount is \$4,265
 - ii. This program provides more extensive coverage than what is offered at the student health center.
- b. Student Success Fee Academic Related Programs

- Olivo invited Rashmi Praba to explain this program. "ARP" is a program to create an opportunity for student learning experiences, such as conferences or lectures.
- ii. Rashmi Praba invited Craig Winton to further explain. This year's cycle has higher applications and approvals. Recommends \$ 2.3 million to be awarded no this year's cycle.

4. ACTIONS ITEMS:

- a. 25-26 Instructionally Related Activities (IRA) Budget
 - i. This year's budget saw an increase consistent with the Higher Education Price Index (HEPI), and was allocated out consistent with previous methodology. There was an additional 1x request from Aztec Student Media group for \$120,150 from reserves, as discussed in the previous meeting.

5. INFORMATION ITEMS:

- a. IRA Alternative Consultation
 - i. Reviewed President's memo outlining the use of alternative consultation process
 - Current consideration to increase IRA fee to support athletics and student athletes. In the future, CFAC is to hear information provided by the fee sponsor, including background on program and financial statement. CFAC will then gather pro and con statements from students. CFAC will ensure information is objective easy to understand for students, then the alternative consultation process will begin.
 - 2. CFAC's immediate next steps are to review Draft Alternate Consultation Process. To be returned to in the future by CFAC in the fall semester.
 - 3. Olivo opened discussion to how to include students and general feedback
 - a. Vincent Lin recommended including housing and cultural centers in the process.
 - b. Taj Henry recommended sending out mass text via the box office to engage students
 - c. Congcong Zheng How long does this process normally take?
 - i. Typically, this process will take a semester, with the goal of having it finalized before March.
 - ii. Other than the suggestions outlined above, there were no concerns with beginning the alternative consultation process for the IRA fee increase.
