T. Call to order - VP Roush called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m. VP Roush inquired if there were any amendments to the agenda and there were none.

II. **Information Items**

2011/12 State Budget - Mid-year Trigger (Attachment 1) - The expected \$100 million trigger cut was enacted. SDSU's portion is \$7,859,700, which is one time in this fiscal A proportional distribution to the divisions of this one time amount is recommended. 2012/13 State Budget - Governor's Budget - The Governor's budget for the CSU describes the budget as "flat," as it incorporates this year's \$100m cut with no additional reductions. However, it includes a \$200 million trigger cut which will be enacted if the Governor's proposed tax increases fail to pass on the Since we won't know until so late in the year we will discuss a November ballot. conservative approach to budgeting for the time being. The Governor's budget also permanently allocated to CSU funding in the amount of state funded debt service on CSU Bond funded buildings; but that debt service increases over time and no funds will be allocated to cover the increase. Similarly, the State budget will no longer provide funding for increases in the PERS Employer Contribution Rate.
