I. Call to order - VP McCarron called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. VP McCarron inquired if there were any amendments to the agenda but there were none.

- **2014/15 Meeting Schedule (Attachment 1)** The attached schedule has been agreed upon by all PBAC members.
- 2014/15 B 2014-01 Budget (Attachment 2) VP McCarron explained the attachment includes anticipated budget over revenue figures through Fall Semester 2014.

VP McCarron attended the system wide Vice Presidents' meeting when the 2014/15 budget was discussed. The Governor proposed \$142.2M for the CSU, CSU proposed \$237M, State Assembly proposed \$232M, and Senate proposed \$237M. The Assembly and Senate agreed to a moratorium on student success fees. The next step is for a committee to reevaluate their budget differences. The final Governor's Budget is scheduled to be signed in June 2014.

- 2013/14 Revenues (Attachment 2) VP McCarron said we are \$70,000 favorable to budget compared to the prior report.
- 2013/14 Reserves (Attachment 3) Director Little presented the reserves and a summary of the funding requests. Encumbrances for multi-year requests are listed.
