

HOW TO PAY SDSU FEES ONLINE

Helpful Information from Student Financial Services

- ▶ Part of the student's learning experience at San Diego State is financial education. Our priority is to assist students in helping them take care of their financial responsibilities.
- ▶ It is very important that students keep their contact information (e-mail, address, and phone number) current with the university. This information is updated on the student's Web portal account.
- ▶ Registration fees must be paid prior to registration unless fees are deferred by financial aid or some other third party agency. The university does not bill for registration fees. Therefore, students are reminded to check their portal account for payment deadlines and their registration date. Registration fees, tuition and parking payments can be made as early as a month prior to registration. Check our Web site for online payment options. If you wish to pay by check, a fee payment coupon can be generated on the student's Web portal account. A registration and out-of-state/foreign tuition installment plan is also available.
- ▶ Electronic Billings are sent around the 20th of every month for other amounts that may come due during the semester. Examples of these types of billings are housing fees, miscellaneous course fees, fines and damage charges, etc. Students and other designated parties will receive an e-mail notification when a billing statement is available online.
- ▶ Students can allow their parents or other authorized users access to their Student Financial Services account by giving them their own account and password. This gives the authorized user access to eBills, payment options, transaction history, and 1098t forms.
- ▶ Students receiving financial aid or scholarships may have their funds deposited into their bank account. Sign up online at www.sdsu.edu/sfs
- ▶ Students who receive Federal Perkins and/or Federal Direct Student Loans need to attend an exit interview in University Collections if they are enrolled in less than 6 units in a semester.
